in the Champlain Islands, Grand Isle County Vermont



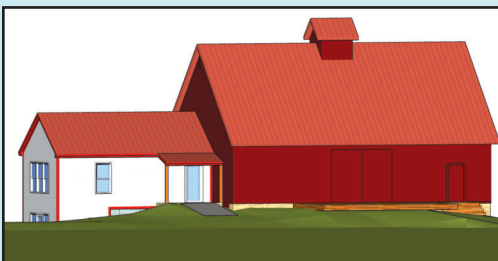
Island Arts, (The Champlain Islands Celebration of the Arts, Inc.) in 2014 was deeded, a beautiful, structurally sound, hundred year old barn. Its inside space is spectacular with original beams, wooden floor and cathedral ceiling. It is truly one of a kind. After multiple upgrades to meet public building codes and with a patched leaky roof, Island Arts opened its door in 2019 showcasing numerous events, performances, workshops and a gallery exhibit.

Everyone entering this iconic barn space is struck by its beauty. Concert goers enjoy superb acoustics. Unfortunately, occasionally one is bothered by the traffic noise from the nearby highway.

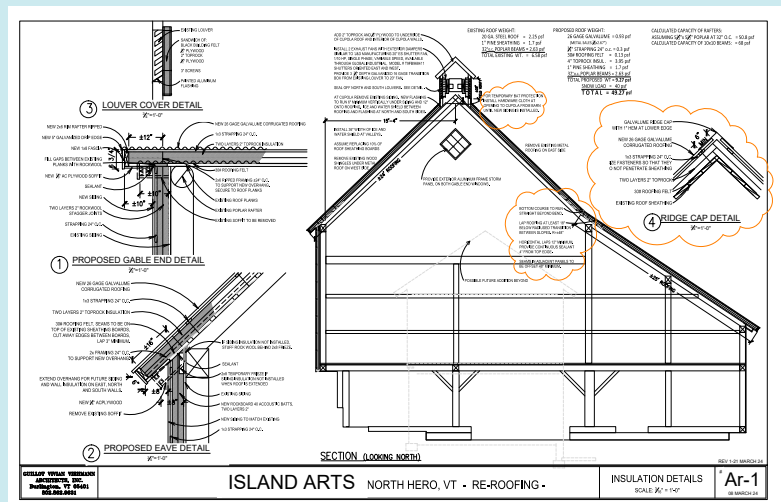
We are looking at a multiple year barn project improvement. With funds gathered, we have already completed in May 2024, electrical upgrades for safety and improved audience comfort. We were also able to plan to replace the old leaky roof and add insulation to minimize/eliminate road and other external noise. With our architect Doug Viehmann of Guillot Vivian Viehmann Architects (GVV) and our contractor, Vermont Construction Company (VTCC) the barn improvements work is starting in September with phase 1A of multiple phases.

In order to proceed to subsequent phases of the barn improvements project we have started a Capital Fundraising Campaign. Donations are gratefully welcome.



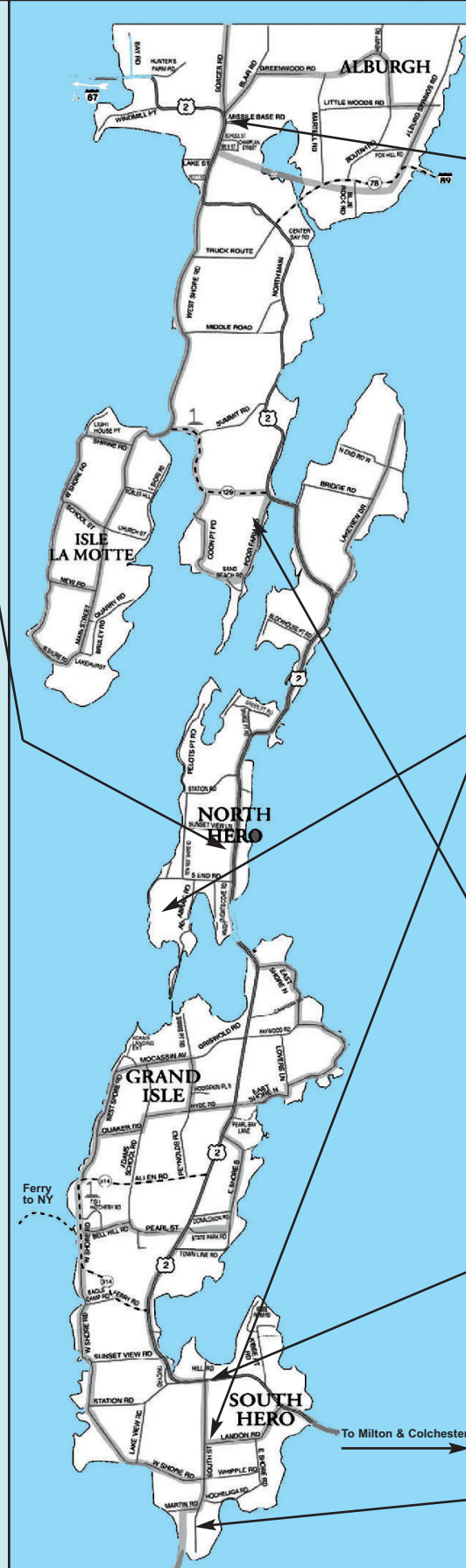
Rendering of the Final Project

FREE FAMILY EVENT

A stargazing event suitable for the whole family and co-sponsored by Island Arts and the Vermont Astronomical Society will be held weather permitting at the end of August. The exact date will be announced depending on weather.

Many exciting events have happened in the 2024 island skies. First and foremost was the April total solar eclipse. The islands were fortunate to have some of the best weather in the United States. Vermont Astronomical Society photographer Richard Whitehead, took fabulous pictures of the total solar eclipse in North Hero in April. On May 10, intense auroras were spawned by a series of massive solar flares and coronal mass ejections that erupted from the sun, something Earth has not seen since the truly epic solar storms of October 2003.

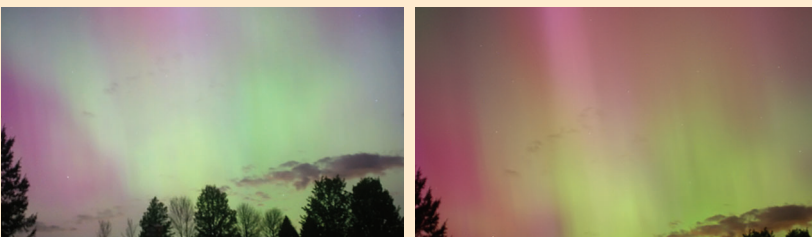


The Spontaneous Evening this year will be the 12th since 2010. Only COVID resulted in cancellation of the event. Last year we not only had clear skies but also very steady seeing which resulted in exceptional views of Saturn. Vermont Public's Elodie Reed documented the event see: <https://www.vermontpublic.org/local-news/2023-11-06/alburgh-vermont-spontaneous-evening-under-stars-telescopes-saturn>.

This year viewing will begin around 8:30 PM. Saturn and its rings will be the first wonder of the evening. As it gets darker, the summer constellations will emerge and participants will have a tour of the sky guided by experienced amateur astronomers using green laser pointers. Several large telescopes will be trained on the many interesting star clusters, galaxies and nebulae visible in the summer skies. The event will be held at Orchard Hill Observatory in South Alburgh VT. The address is 70 Poor Farm Road, 05440. There is parking on site.

Coming from the south on route 2 through North Hero Village, the entrance to Poor Farm Road is the first left after the North Hero-South Alburgh bridge. The observatory is located on the right 0.7 mi from the entrance to Poor Farm Road. A sign will be at the entrance to the driveway.

Coming from the north on route 2, the entrance to Poor Farm Road is on the right just before the South Alburgh-North Hero bridge.

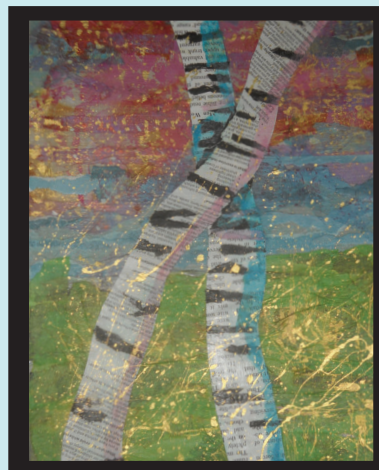
